## Camp Ras

Professional childcare will be available for children affected by Costello syndrome and their siblings ages 1-17 years by July 24, 2025. Camp Ras cannot accept children under 12 months of age. Childcare is specifically provided so adults may attend the medical lectures on Thursday and the family workshops on Saturday morning. To utilize childcare, you are expected to attend these sessions; this ensures you can be quickly located should an issue arise with your child. *Children are not permitted in the meeting rooms in consideration of the attendees.* Parents will be responsible for administering medicines and/or tube feedings. **The \$100 per child registration fee covers both days and is non-refundable.**
